

# Online to Print Article

---

Given an existing online article, turn it into a magazine article using InDesign. To complete this assignment, follow the instructions below:

1. Use the internet to find an article of interest to you. Copy the text (title, author, and body) of the article and paste it into a Word document. Make modifications to the text as necessary (size alignment, spacing, etc.) to make it usable. Save this document as “Magazine Article”.
2. Place your Magazine Article document into a new InDesign document (Letter size, Portrait orientation).
3. Look at your article to decide how you will incorporate different design elements based on the topic, style, and audience of your article. Here are some design elements to consider:
  - a. Typeface
  - b. Color of text
  - c. Size
  - d. Dropcaps or Pull Quotes
  - e. Columns
  - f. Indents
  - g. Alignment
  - h. Bullets & Numbering
4. Use the tools and typefaces in InDesign to change you plain (and boring) article into a professional and interesting magazine article. As you work, keep in mind the topic of the article, the style or layout of the article, and the article’s audience. Each of these factors is important to the design of the magazine article.
5. Save your document as “Magazine Article”. Print a copy of your article on the color printer (Printer: dchs-116-clrprn). Write your name on the back of the printed page.
